News from June – What's been happening?

The last few weeks have been exciting and busy. The children have been taking part in a wide range of amazing activities.

Cambridge University Botanical Gardens

Over the course of two days the whole Federation travelled to Cambridge to visit the Botanic Gardens. The weather was good, and the children had a fantastic time showing real curiosity and creativity.

While we were there the children 'travelled' the world visiting diverse biomes. They experienced vastly different environments and learnt how plants adapt to survive. The children also demonstrated amazing art skills as they completed their life drawing of plants, just as botanists from the past have done. The large grounds of the gardens were the perfect place to learn about map reading using six figure grid references in an orienteering challenge. The younger children did bark rubbing and worked together to discover the age of trees by measuring circumferences with their own bodies and compared with standard measures too. The lovely fountains provided a super resource to complete a Shape Safari too. One child said, "It's just like Forest School!"

What fantastic sportspeople our children are! They raced with great enthusiasm and encouraged each other with kindness and generosity. The sun shone and it was great, at last, to be able to have such a lovely 'whole community' event in school. Thank you for your support.
