English

In English this term, we are looking at:

- Biography.
- Extended blog entry.
- Narrative.

Reading for pleasure and enjoyment is a large focus of our English. Please continue to support and encourage reading at home as well as at school; reading regularly to adults and being read to is still important in Key Stage 2.

RWI books should be returned and changed once your child is fluent when reading it. Please make sure to record when your child has read their book using their reading record.

Those children who are free readers can keep books at home until they are finished, but please bring in reading records daily so we can see that reading is being done. Children who are free readers can read their own books at home but please record these in reading records (books from home can also be read in school).

Maths

In Maths, the areas we will be looking at this term are: place value, addition and subtraction, properties of shape, multiplication and division, fractions, decimals, co-ordinates, translating shapes and measurements of mass, length and time.

Science

This term, our focus of study for science will be 'Electricity'.

Homework

Homework will be sent home weekly on Wednesdays and is due back the following Monday. Spellings may be sent different days as it will be linked with spellings being done in class. Children should also be using TTRockstars and reading daily. Please make sure you sign your child's reading record once they have read at home.

History

Our topic for this term is 'Benin'. We will be learning about the Eweka dynasty, its importance and where the history of Benin sits in the context of African history.

Geography

In geography, we will be focusing on Africa, linking to our History topic. We will be studying both human and physical geography such as types of settlement and land use and economic activity including trade links.

PE

Year 6 will be doing PE on Fridays. Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for both indoor and outdoor PE. Swimming is on Friday mornings for Years 4 and 5 - please make sure that your child brings their swimming kit to school on this day.

DT

In DT, we will be researching, designing and making our own latex moulds.

Art

In the first half term, we will be looking at Batik. Batik is the art of wax-resistant dye on fabrics to create beautiful and colourful designs.

RE

This term, the children will be learning about the religion of Hinduism in RE.

Music and German

In music, the children will learn about samba and carnival sounds and instruments as well as looping and remixing. Mrs Simpson will be in on Thursday afternoons to teach German.

Computing

In computing, the children will be learning all about computing systems and networks, including search engines.

PSHE

Our PSHE topics this term are 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Difference'.
