This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils' music education.

Part A: Curriculum music

This is about what we teach in lesson time, how much time is spent teaching music and any music qualifications or awards that pupils can achieve.

We use Kapow to plan and support delivery of music from Reception to Year 6. The units are outlined in our curriculum overview on the long term overviews.

Part B: Co-curricular music

Through the year the school offers an after school singing club for those pupils in Year 2 – Year 6.

The school signposts pupils to local clubs etc. who offer instrument loan and support for either individual tuition or groups.

This is about all the other musical events and opportunities that we organise, such as singing in assembly, concerts and shows, and trips to professional concerts.

This year pupils will take part in various musical performances including Harvest Festival, Christmas Productions & End of Year Production. Some of these are supported by Act II Theatre Company.
