English

In English this term we are looking at narrative poetry, mystery stories and explanation texts and we will continue to use Read, Write Inc. spelling. Spelling tests will continue on Monday mornings (**spellings are on the school website**).

In class, our Guided reading sessions will be focusing on inference and deduction skills, as well as guided comprehensions and other reading skills. Reading for pleasure and enjoyment is a large focus of our English. In class we are going to continue with our class text from last term.

Please continue to support and encourage reading at home as well as at school, reading regularly to adults and being read to is still important in KS2.

Reading books to be changed need to be returned to school Thursday and will be sent home the following Monday. Children who are free readers can read their own books at home but please record these in reading records- these should be bought into school regularly for us to check what is being read. (Books from home can also be read in school if they are quarantined when first brought in).

Maths

In Maths some of the areas we will be looking at this term are- negative numbers, addition and subtraction/ algebra, shape, multiplication and division, fractions and measurement. Also remember to keep practicing times tables on TTrackstars.

Homework

Homework will be sent home on Monday's (every other week) and is due back the following Monday. Late work will not always be marked as it has to be quarantined. On weeks homework is not sent children must be using TTrackstars which is checked.

Science

This term our focus of study is Properties and Changes of materials.

History

Our topic for this term is Ancient Egyptians. We will be learning what is meant by the term 'ancient' civilisation, about their religion, Egyptian society and why the Nile was so important to the Ancient Egyptians.

Geography

Our Geography topics will be studying- Rivers - The Nile, Human and Economic use of rivers, Impact of rivers on society and The Water Cycle

PE

PE will continue to be taught by Mr Barron on **Fridays**. PE this term will be invasion games. PE will be outdoors so ensure children are dressed appropriately.

DT

In DT we are going to be completing our Roman mosaics.

Art

Our focus in Art this term is sculpture and we will be looking at the work of Henry Moore.

RE

In the first half term we will be look at how beliefs can be expressed through the Arts.

Music and German

Karl will be in on Fridays to teach Music and Mrs Simpson will be in on Thursday afternoons to teach German.

PSHE

Our PSHE topics over the next term are Thinking Positive and Growing Up.
