English

In English this term we are looking at historical narratives, persuasion and explanation texts and we will continue to use Read, Write Inc. spelling.

Spelling tests will usually be on Monday mornings.

Reading for pleasure and enjoyment is a large focus of our English. Please continue to support and encourage reading at home as well as at school, reading regularly to adults and being read to is still important in KS2.

RWI books should be returned and changed twice a week once they have been read with adults and recorded in reading records.

Those children who are free readers can keep books at home until they are finished, but please bring in reading record weekly so we can see that reading is being done. Children who are free readers can read their own books at home but please record these in reading records. (Books from home can also be read in school).

Library books will be books children have chosen for enjoyment but may need to be read with an adult and can be returned and swapped as soon as they are finished.

Maths

In Maths some of the areas we will be looking at this term are- place value, addition and subtraction, properties of shape, multiplication, fractions, coordinates, decimals and mass. Please remember to keep practicing times tables on TTrockstars, login details will be given to children.

Homework

Homework will be sent home weekly on Wednesday's and is due back the following Monday. Spellings may be sent different days as it will be linked with spellings being done in class. Children should also be using TTRockstars and reading daily.

Science

This term our focus of study is Animals including Humans.

History

Our topic for this term is World War II- Battle of Britain. We will be learning about why the Battle of Britain was a significant turning point in British history.

Geography

Our Geography topic is about locating the world's countries using maps and building on prior learning.

PΕ

PE will be on Thursday this term. PE will be outdoors so ensure children are dressed appropriately.

DТ

In DT we are going to be doing a cookery project after half term, which will link to our history and maths.

Art

In the first half term we will be learning about the artist Jackson Pollock and creating our own art work in his style.

This term we will be looking at Christianity and how the Bible teaches Christians to treat others.
