<b>human</b>	a person, a human being
<b>offspring</b>	a child or young of a parent or an animal
<b>generation</b>	the average period between the birth of parents and their offspring, for example daughter, mother and grandmother

<b>present</b>	existing at this time
<b>future</b>	time that is yet to come

## Sight

Your eyes let you see what is around you. Sometimes people need glasses to make their sight clearer.



## Hearing

Your ears let you hear what is going on around you. We can hear soft, quiet sounds and heavy, loud noises.

## Touch

Your skin gives you the sense of touch. It tells you if things are soft and warm or smooth and cold.

## Smell

Your nose is designed to detect smells. It tells your brain if something smells good or bad.

## Taste

Your mouth and tongue help you to taste. Your taste buds can keep you safe from eating rotten food.
